<p>Indication</p>	<p>Prevention of the following symptoms in cataract surgeries: Post-operative inflammation, intraoperative miosis, cystoid macular edema related with lens extraction and intraocular lens implantation</p> <p>Treatment of inflammation in anterior segment of the eyes: Non-infectious inflammations including chronic conjunctivitis and post-traumatic inflammation</p>
<p>Active Ingredient</p>	<p>Diclofenac Sodium 1 mg/mL</p>
<p>Description</p>	<p>Colorless or pale yellow, clear, aqueous ophthalmic solution</p>
<p>Dosage & Administration</p>	<p>For cataract surgery:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Preoperative: Instill 1 drop into the affected eye(s) 5 times during 3 hours of time 2) Right after the surgery: Instill 1 drop into the affected eye(s) 3 times 3) Maintenance: Instill 1 drop into the affected eye(s) 3~5 times daily (administration period can be adjusted based upon the symptoms) <p>For inflammation in the anterior segment of the eyes: Instill 1 drop into the affected eye(s) 4~5 times daily</p>
